The two most significant dates of graduation week awaiting you and your senior student are June 9 and June 10. Baccalaureate, a non-denominational, inspirational observance, will be shared this year, for the third time, with the graduates of Edison High School and Westminster High School at Golden West College, at 2:00 p.m. A reception will follow the event at 3:00 p.m. No tickets are required for the Baccalaureate. On June 10, Huntington Beach High School will hold its commencement ceremonies for the Class of 1976 at 7:00 p.m. at Sheue Field.

I should like to take this time to ask your cooperation in making the graduation ceremonies the event of a lifetime for your graduating senior. As you are aware, the commencement ceremonies provide the school and its community an opportunity to recognize the academic achievement of the school's graduates. Although joyous in nature, graduation is a formal occasion. Unfortunately, past ceremonies have been marred by isolated disruptions from graduates and members of the audience. At the request of students and staff, I am asking that you and your guests please observe the following procedures on June 10. They are meant to serve as guidelines for insuring a beautiful evening.

1. Please enter stadium from Main Street entrance. The interior campus entrance is reserved for student processional only. For those parking in the main lot (entrance via Utica), please walk through the campus to Main St., and north to the entrance.
