Campus Tour: We discussed setting up a campus tour of HBHS for the Sunday morning (10:00 a.m.) after the Saturday evening reunion.

Music & Dancing: Chris offered to contact Tim Young to act as our music and dance deejay. Tim deejayed for the Class of '77 reunion with apparent success. The Survey Monkey results revealed that 37 respondents (a clear majority) wanted recorded music at the reunion, the choices being, in order of preference: 70's music, rock, oldies, country.

Compiling Contact Info: Kathy offered to contact Corinne Elliot to build a class contact list. Lynn will upgrade her Classmates.com account to "Gold" to obtain some of the extra contact info and features there.

Table and Banquet Room Decorations: It was agreed that decorations should focus on HBHS-related themes, rather than the City of HB. Doug will 3D print some HBHS towers for centerpieces and Lynn will make some mock-ups for our consideration. Tom will look into obtaining some swag for giveaways, and Chris will talk to Amy Mason.

HBHS Faculty: Patty offered to query HBHS to see whether students might be able to make a photo faculty collage for a school project.

Reunion Finance: Doug and Lynn will set up a reunion bank account to receive funds from attendees and purchase supplies, etc. We agreed that any money leftover from paying reunion expenses will be donated to HBHS. It was agreed that the fee would be set at \$76 per attendee. The question was raised of whether to adjust the fee up and down for early-bird reservations and latecomers (e.g., \$65 for early reservations, and \$90 for latecomers).
